- Gardner-Webb offers 21 varsity sports at the NCAA Division I level. All games are open to the general public
- Cleveland County is a certified entrepreneurial community (CEC®). CEC's make a commitment to ongoing action planning and implementation of entrepreneurial activities
- The Small Business Center at Cleveland Community College provides workshops, seminars, counseling, information, and referral services for small business owners and operators in Cleveland County. This group works with the Chamber of Commerce, Uptown Shelby, and CC Business Development Center.
- Boiling Springs is the only municipality in the county that offers curbside recycling pick-up thanks for our partnership with Republic Waste Services

Code Enforcement Corner

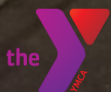
